The recently-opened Stavros Niarchos Foundation Cultural Centre (SNFCC), Athens, aspires to be a new monument to culture, learning and humanity. Over the last 10 years, Expedition Engineering and Omete have been working with Renzo Piano Building Workshop to design the SNFCC; comprising new homes for the Greek National Library, the Greek National Opera, and a large, much needed, Public Park.
